THE TIDE HAS STARTED TO TURN

Companies that swiftly embraced leftist radical ideology are realigning their positions following Conservative Patriot protests. From retail stores to major sports leagues, these businesses realize that there is another view that's equally as important to their company's bottom line. While most companies are not (yet) abandoning leftist doctrine, many plan to scale back future support for events and merchandise.

In the latest Gallup poll, 69 percent of Americans said that transgender athletes should only be allowed to compete "on teams that match their birth gender." That is up from 62 percent in 2021. In that same survey, 55 percent of Americans said that it's "morally wrong" to change one's gender, which is up from 51 percent.

In 2023, 23 percent of shareholders embraced environmental, social, and corporate governance (known as ESG) compared to 36.6 percent in 2022 and 50 percent in 2021, per the Sustainable Investments Institute.

The tide is turning because Conservative Patriots are pushing back. Here are other reasons to believe that the tide is turning toward basic American Conservative values:

- = Some students at Marshall Simons Middle School in Burlington, Massachusetts refused to celebrate Pride.
- = In February, Major League Baseball Commissioner Rob Manfred told teams that players should NOT wear Pride rainbow-themed caps or uniform patches. MLB's directive only became known in recent weeks.
- NHL Commissioner Gary Bettman has said that pride nights at NHL games have "become more of a distraction."
- Many parents in the Glendale Unified School District recently protested Pride celebrations planned at schools.
- = Anheuser-Busch has lost \$27 billion in corporate value since the boycott of Bud Lite started. Many analysts predict the brand will never regain its customer base.
- = Target has lost \$15 billion in corporate value since their customer boycott started.
- = Following calls for a boycott, Kohl's has greatly reduced prices on its Pride merchandise both in the store and online. (Guess there aren't that many people looking for Pride clothes for INFANTS and CHILDREN.)
- = The all-Muslim Hamtramck, Michigan City Council, with a population of 27,000, voted to only allow city and state flags and flags from nations represented in its population to fly over city buildings. Private businesses can fly whatever flags they want.
- = The Orange County Board of Supervisors voted that only government flags should fly from county buildings, i.e., Stars and Stripes, California, state flag, MIA/POW flag. Private businesses can fly whatever flags they want.

Kudos to Conservative Patriots of Orange County (CPOC), a growing and influential organization that rallies members to attend the biweekly BOS meetings where many attendees comment on issues. We believe that this vote passed 3:2 because of CPOC's activist determination.

- = Starbucks is said to have initiated a no decorations policy prior to the start of June. The company did not refer to Pride but focused on all kinds of decorations in their establishments.
- = The Fox News boycott continues along, as Tucker Carlson has millions more listeners on his "Tucker on Twitter" posts. MSNBC won the primetime ratings war the week of June 4. Unless there is a last-minute data reporting change, Fox News 120-week-long primetime winning streak is over.
- = Leading female athletes are demanding that biological men (aka trans women) compete in their own category and not with biological women.
- = Corporations that embraced Pride, are seeing (or will soon see) shareholder lawsuits filed demanding to know why the corporation wasted corporate assets, damaged the company's brand and reputation and in some instances created a hostile work environment for its Conservative employees.
- = An empty Dodger Stadium Friday night was a "win the battle." An empty Dodger Stadium the next day, the day after that ... is a "win the war."
